

The story is a prequel to the games, starring Holland as a younger Drake, showing us details of how he came to meet and befriend Sully. Available in cinemas.






# Blessing Manafa



"Jireh" is a song performed by American contemporary worship band Elevation Worship and Maverick City Music, which features vocals from Chandler Moore and Naomi Raine.


